Refilling & Re-using plastic containers

Refilling guidelines



All previous liquid must be finished/disposed of and the container rinsed out with water before being re-filled.



Fill container from the refill bottle.

Ensure that you are always using the same product in the container. Don't overfill, to allow space for the cap/trigger spray.



Wipe and dry container after refilling.

Recording Batch Numbers

It is important for QC traceability that the correct Batch Number (B/N) is recorded on any refilled containers. Before refilling any containers, please check that the B/Ns on both the container being refilled and the refill bottle match.

If the B/Ns do not match, ensure that you record the B/N of the refill bottle on the container you are refilling. You can do this by using a combination of the below options:



Use a permanent marker to write the B/N on the container



 Add a label with the B/N on to the container, or request a fresh label from the product manufacturer
